## Provides comprehensive toolkit of learning materials on running a social enterprise

- Supplies fair trade NJaTC products for sales and practical learning (i.e. tea, coffee, rice, chocolate)
- ✓ Gives access to resource website

- Provides logistical support; an online shop, bank accounts, ordering, product shipping/delivery, online billing and customer support
- Gives access to Mentors and Peer networks
- Uses our fair trade links with poor producers overseas. Working together to reduce poverty and suffering through social enterprise!

## The student group:

- Chooses a social enterprise model, creates a constituted group, holds regular meetings
  - ✔ Creates a business plan
  - ✓ Works as a team to manage the social enterprise
- ✓ Researches and sells to different 'markets' using fair trade products supplied by NJaTC
  - Publicises and organises community sales events
- ✓ 'Plugs-in' to NJaTC's resource website and online learning platform
- Manages ordering and stock control
  - ✓ Generates income & invests profit for group/school

## The school/college:

- ✔ Provides a place for the Student Group to meet
- ✔ Provides a secure area for products to be stored
- Provides stationery and computer access
- Provides an adult as Group supporter and bank signatory
- ✓ Completes NJaTC license agreement
